

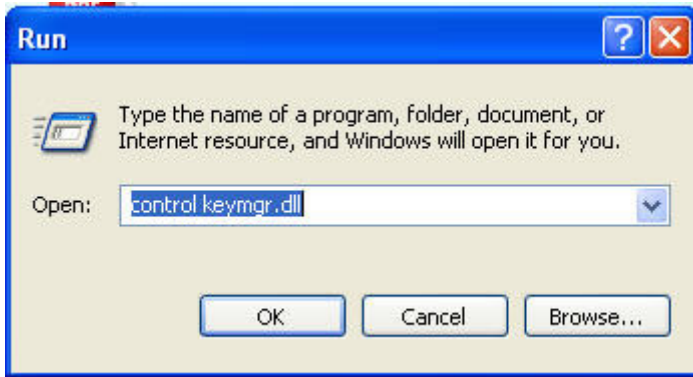
How to remove/ manage stored network passwords

The situation may arise where you accidentally checked the “Remember my Password” box when making a network connection to the Roswell shared storage resource X9000 on a public use computer. This procedure removes the stored password. The public computers are the acquisition computers connected to the LSRII-A/B and Fortessa user Flow Cytometers.

Click “Start” and then “Run” button lower right of menu.



Within the “Open” dialog box, type **control keymgr.dll** click **OK**.



You will get a list of stored network resources containing stored passwords. Highlight the stored network resource and select “Remove” to delete it. Finally, select “OK” to commit to delete.



This is necessary to prevent the next user from using your Roswell logon credentials to access your networked resources due to being mistakenly saved.

This utility is also navigable through “Control Panel”...”User Accounts”...”Administrator” upper left side under related tasks click “Manage My Passwords”.

When finished, Log out of Windows to clear the cache
